**Entry Requirements:** Bachelor of Science in Nursing from a recognized institution; Registered as a registered nurse (RN) in good standing in their country of origin; Minimum of 1,125 hours of nursing experience within the last four years prior to application; Overall IELTS Academic 6.5 (with no band below 6.0. Must pass an assessment test and an interview with the Program Leader.
